

Department 1: Food Preservation

Divisions: Adult and Junior

Rules:

- No artificial flavoring or coloring may be used (ex. food coloring, jello, etc.)
- No paraffin on jelly.
- Low acid foods, like vegetables, must be pressure canned. High acid and acidified foods, like tomatoes, pickles, jams, and jellies must be processed in a boiling water canner or pressure canned.
- No canned squash including summer, zucchini, or spaghetti. *Pickled summer squash and zucchini are allowed.*
- Potatoes must be whole or cubed, no pureed or mashed potatoes. No pureed or mashed pumpkin.
- Canning jars must be of appropriate size and clear Mason type. Lids and rings MUST be metal. No plastic lids or rings are allowed.

All food preservation entries will need to be labeled with product name, method of preservation, and date canned and placed on front of jar.

Labels should not obstruct the judge's ability to see the product!

All food preservation entries MUST have been preserved within the past 12 months. NO exceptions!



Department 2: Confections

Divisions: Adult and Junior

Rules:

- No product may be made from mixes, except cakes entered in decorated cakes.
- The decorated cakes can be decorated props and dummies judged on design, etc.
- All products (except iced cakes) must be exhibited in clear wrapping and on plain, white paper plates or foil covered cardboard.
- Pie crust must be made by exhibitor.
- Loaf breads must be a ½ loaf min. or plate of 4 other than loaf type (biscuits, rolls, etc.)



Department 3: Household Arts

Divisions: Adult and Junior

Rules:

- Items must be the work of the exhibitor. No Professional needlework will be accepted.



Department 5: Photography

Divisions: Adult and Junior

Rules:

- All work must be framed, matted, or backed with construction paper to assure ease in hanging.
- Photos need to be labeled with the correct category listed.
Professionals are not eligible for premium money and will be judged separately.



Department 10: Art

Divisions: Adult, Junior, Pee Wee

Rules:

- Art must be framed or matted, suitable for hanging, otherwise it will not be accepted.



Department 11: Floriculture

Divisions: Adult and Junior

Rules:

- All house plants must have been owned by the exhibitor at least three months.
- Previously entered plants are eligible.
- Only **ONE** Wildflower allowed per Exhibitor.



Department 12: Horticulture

Divisions: Adult and Junior

Rules:

- The Product must be genuine cultivated product.
- Display applies to each variety.
